

Accru Privacy Policy



The Accru network within Australia and New Zealand (Accru) is committed to maintaining the privacy and confidentiality of personal information. Accru is subject to the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1988 in Australia and the relevant privacy legislation in New Zealand. Accordingly we adhere to national privacy principles when collecting, using, disclosing, securing and providing access to personal information.

How we handle personal information
